





Get A Ham Radio License at the 2026 FRVA Convention!

In times of natural or man-made disaster, or when far from phones and cell towers, amateur radio is often the only means of emergency communication. In addition, amateur radio using mobile or portable equipment is an engaging way to enjoy parks and campgrounds. Using amateur radio, though, requires an FCC license.



Prior to the 2026 FRVA Convention in Perry, Georgia, the FRVA Amateur Radio Chapter will be offering a one-day course to obtain the entry-level amateur radio license, followed by the FCC exam the next morning. The training session will occur on Monday, March 16, 2026, with the exam given the following morning. Early arrivals at the

Their vocal blend and harmonies are really a major part of the 2MS sound. Combine all the above, with their tight, tasteful musical arrangements and it's a presentation that is appealing to dancers and listeners at a comfortable sound level for everyone.


