## Perry Update

t last count it was reported that over 1800 RV's have registered for FMCA's 106th International Convention & RV Expo in Perry, GA in March. If you have not yet registered, don't despair, the Georgia National Fairgrounds is a huge facility so you still have time to register.





We are expecting a large contingency of Frustrated Maestros, including many *First Timers*, so here is some information you will need to know before arriving in Perry.

#### **Frustrated Maestros Arrival Date**

As volunteers, Sunday, March 12th is the specified arrival date for the Frustrated Maestros. Specific arrival information will be detailed in your Rally Packet from FMCA, such as arrival window and which gate to use.

#### **Red & Whites**

Maestros are expected to wear "Red & Whites" for all performances and official events unless otherwise excepted. Red means a RED shirt or top of almost any style (in good taste). "White" means white pants. White pants are sometimes hard to find, especially in men's sizes. Some have found that painter's pants work well. They are usually available at paint stores such as Sherwin-Williams.

#### What Else Should I Bring?

You should have your own music stand. It is sometimes beneficial to have a music stand light if you have one, but don't go running out to buy one if you haven't already got one. Also bring any special accessories you might need such as mutes, horn stands, mute stands, etc.

We are a very social group and will almost always find a way to have an afternoon "Happy Hour". You may wish to bring things to share at some of the "Happy Hours".

## Music-Music-Music

he two music books that every Maestro should own are the *Original Red Book*, and the *Modern Red Book* (sometimes referred to as the Rocky Mtn. Red Book).

When you open the link you will see lots of different music folders, but right now just concern yourself with the Red Book folders. The easiest way to get all of the Red Book music printed out is to download the specific folders you will need and take it to an Office Depot/ Office Max store and have them print it for you. FMCA has a discount program with them and the cost is very reasonable. You can find the information on the FMCA WEB site under "Discount Programs. All you should need is the account number which is <a href="https://discount-programs-but/911308">01187111308</a>. Some stores can two side print for you and some may print on pre-punched paper making it easier to put in a three ring binder.

When you first open the link to Charlie Kennington's drop box you will see several folders for the Red Book. Look for the one that is the key that you need for your instrument. For example, most trumpets are keyed to Bb, so you should download that folder to a storage device such as a thumb drive. Chorus members should download the C-folders. For the Original Red Book there is an additional folder labeled RED BOOK 132-146. When you open this folder look for the file in it that is keyed for your instrument and download it to your thumb drive.

Go back to the first page of the drop box and look for the folder that says "Rocky Mtn. Modern Red Book". Open this folder and look for the file that is keyed for your instrument and download it to the thumb drive. You are now ready to find your nearest Office Depot and get both books printed out. Be sure you only get the files for the two Red Books printed—not everything in Charlie's drop box. Also, it is a good idea to get two sided copying if possible. It really cuts down on the weight you need to haul to rehearsals and performances.

One last suggestion: if you have the capability to download the other music from Charlie's drop box to your computer, it may come in handy down the road. Just don't worry about making hard copies of it now.

#### & GEAR


