Arrival Monday April 15, depart Thursday April 18, 2024 (3 nights)

Misty Mountain RV Resort is west of Charlottesville, VA before Afton Mountain. If traveling I-64 take Exit 107 West on Route 250. Nine sites have been reserved (FMCA Colonial Virginians/Jerry Clemmer). They are sites 5-10 (40 feet) and sites 11-23 (65 feet). All sites are pull-through with full-hookups (50 amp). Clemmers are on site 11 and Coopers are on site 12 next to the Club Room which is reserved (no charge) for Colonial Virginians. The campground has approximately 95 RV sites and about 12 cabins across a creek and up on a hill. The campground is eliminating cable TV and upgrading to WIFI.

Rates are approximately \$70 per night after 10% group discount applied at check-in. Reservations must be made at least one month in advance because the campground will remove the sites from the reserved category. Check-in is 1:00 pm and check-out is 12:00 noon.

There are numerous wineries, brewers, distilleries, restaurants, and other attractions in the area.



An attraction that has been open only a few years is the "Blue Ridge Tunnel Trail" an old railroad tunnel through Afton Mountain. The tunnel is about one mile long and accessible from US route 250 on the Waynesboro/Western side and from Route 6 on the Afton/Eastern side. There is a trail on either side before reaching the tunnel, eastern side is upgrade and western side is downgrade. There is no charge. Biking is permitted. Good hiking/waterproof boots/shoes, raincoat/umbrella, and flashlight are recommended.
