Colonial Virginian's President's Message for May 2025

It is great to be relaxing today at Madison Vines RV Resort and Cottages. The campground has many amenities, is on US Route 29 a couple miles south of Madison, VA. Ellen and Ken Kane are great Rally Hosts. Weather has been nice with meals outside at the Kane's RV. Weather has been great for campfire at night. Family RVing Association (FRVA) Eastern Area monthly "Zoom" meeting was held at 7:30 pm Thursday April 17, 2025. FRVA membership is down to 56K from 70K a year ago. There was discussion from the 25 participants about how to attract new members. Some felt a single sheet listing FRVA benefits and having schedules for rallies would be beneficial. RVOvernights is a new FRVA partner with many locations for an overnight stay for a membership fee of \$29.95 per year. FRVA is no longer associated with Harvest Hosts. A new Chapter benefit will be Chapter affiliate links that will provide Chapters with a \$10 commission for every new member recruited. A date to remember is "RV There Yet?" Discovery Channel May 10. At the National Convention at Gillette, WY July 16-19, 2025, four National Officers will be elected. National Directors need to attend to vote. Member Lee Deal has graciously agreed to represent CV Chapter at Gillettte since CV National Directors will not be at Gillette. GEAR (Great Eastern Area Rally) is November 5-9, 2025 at Ocean Lakes, Myrtle Beach, SC. Reservations must be made for sites with Ocean Lakes. FRVA GEAR 25 Rally Applications should be in the July-August FRVA magazine.

Eastern Area is hosting the National Convention at Perry, GA March 18-26, 2026. Chairs are being recruited for the event. There was discussion about EA Staff (Volunteers) being able to host Perry and GEAR in 2026. There was a motion to cancel GEAR in 2026 and the motion passed unanimously. GEAR 2026 will be cancelled at Lewisburg, WV and scheduled for 2027. A National Convention will be in Perry, GA and Gillette, WY in 2027. It is difficult for FRVA to find facilities that are affordable and suitable for National Rallies.

FRVA Council needs National Directors to participate. National Directors are encouraged to join the Council to look at reorganization. Feedback from Perry, GA attendees is that FRVA

takes to long to make decisions. It is also hard to maintain 15 members in a Chapter. Electronic voting should be available at National Conventions so National Directors can vote.

David Fowler, GEAR 2025 Rally Master reported that 117 have registered at Ocean Lakes for GEAR. RV Basics will be taught November 3-4, Golf Carts can be rented for \$25 per day.

Reminder for upcoming CV Rallies is Crosswinds Family Campground, Linwood, NC May 7-10, 2025 hosted by Coopers and Clemmers, June 16-19, 2025 Rudd's Creek Campground, Boydton, VA and Clemmer's residence hosted by Antons and Clemmers., July 9-13, 2025, Tuckahoe Steam and Gas Association Show (no host, dry camping) arranged by Clemmers, Easton MD. There are no CV Rallies scheduled for July, August, September, or October 2025. More information will be e provided for the June Rally in the June issue of Colonial Crier.

Colonial Virginians Bugg's Island Rally Monday June 16, 2025 to Thursday June 19, 2025 (three nights) Hosts Jerry & Brenda Clemmer & John & Carol Anton Updated 12/29/2024

In my younger years my vision was that Bugg's Island Lake and Kerr Lake were two separate lakes. In my high school years, a trip to Bugg's Island Lake revealed to me that when the lake was being developed the law-makers in Virginia and North Carolina could not agree on a name for the lake. Virginia named the lake "Bugg's Island" because of an island in the Roanoke River which is to this day, just below the dam. North Carolina on the other-hand, named the lake Kerr Lake (pronounced "car") in honor of a government official named John H. Kerr. There is another small reservoir in western North Carolina with the same name.

Please see the site map of Rudds Creek Campground (on Bugg's Island Lake) on the following page. There are many good sites, however, the area most suited to larger RVs is the last loop, farthest from the Campground entrance. The last loop has sites 53E through 100E. All are nice sites with water and 30 or 50 amps. There is a dump station. The section was recently walked and the following sites are recommended:

56E, 60E, 61E, 63E, 66E, 67E, 71E, 73E*, 75E*, 77E* 78E*, 79E*, 80E*, 85E*, 86E, 88E*, 89E, 90E, 94E, 91E*, 95E*, and 96E. The * indicates the 10 best sites.

It appears to me that reservations for CV June 2025 Rally can be made after December 16, 2024 at 10:00 am or later. The website is "Recreation.gov" ------ "Rudds Creek Rec. AR., John H. Kerr Dam and Reservoir" or "Campsites for Rudds Creek Rec. AR., John H. Kerr Dam".

This is being sent at this time due to the "Army Core of Engineers" reservation system which has some flaws.

Meals and other activities will be held at Clemmer's home about 2 miles from Rudds Creek Campground entrance. More information will be provided in future Newsletters.



CV "No Host Rally" July 9-13, 2025, 11472 Ocean Gateway, Easton, MD 21601

The 2025 annual Tuckahoe Steam & Gas Engine Show website has not been updated on the Internet at this time. An inquiry was emailed to Show promoters in early January. The January 8, 2025 reply is below. The local campgrounds recommended are MD State Parks and appear to be more suited for small RVs or tents and have limited electrical service.

The Clemmers will be parking on the show grounds and dry camping. We should plan to arrive together if we want to park together. Please note that the email below indicates that we attended the 2024 show. The Clemmers did not attend the 2024 show. Please let Clemmers know if you plan to attend in July 2025.

Good morning Jerry, thank you for your inquiry and happy new year to you and yours!

We're glad you enjoyed our 2024 show and are looking forward to seeing you all again! The dates for our big annual steam show for 2025 are July 10th-13th (Thursday-Sunday). Camping (and camping in groups) is permitted, however we can't guarantee a big group being together as the camping spots are first/come/first serve. Camping spots start at the end of the machine shop and loop around that perimeter of the grounds back towards the gate, and camping spots are also available in the field (opposite side of the grounds). There is a camping fee of \$15/day (in addition to initial show admission). Dry camping is perfect as these spots do not have utility hookups (however you are most welcome to use the restrooms on the grounds, which do have showers). If anyone would prefer a nearby campground which does have utility connections, the two most near the show would be Tuckahoe State Park and Martinak State Park.

Thank you again, and we certainly look forward to seeing you in July! Please feel free to write back or call if you have additional questions or if I can be of any further assistance at this time.

Although these sites are boon docking, a freshwater wagon and gray and black tank contents removal truck (two different trucks) are available upon request with a service charge.
