Music Camp



If you have been sitting on the fence post about whether or not to participate in Music Camp this October, alas, it is not too late. It will be held at Hideaway RV Resort in Myrtle Beach, SC beginning on Tuesday, October 28th and running through Friday, October 31st. We will also be staying at Hideaway for the three rehearsal days for the GREAT EASTERN AREA Rally (GEAR), Saturday, November 1st through Monday, November 3rd. On Tuesday we will relocate to Ocean Lakes Family Campground for GEAR, about 4 miles down the road. See box for "Music Camp & GEAR: Key Dates" below.

We have blown through the 20-site guarantee that Hideaway held for us, but a recent check with the General Manager showed that they could still accommodate more Frustrated Maestro Music Campers. Make sure you indicate the "Maestros" when you make a reservation so you get our discount. Call 843-444-2119 to make a reservation. You can make a reservation for all or any part of the time. Please let Bruce Taylor know that you are coming and for what days.



The Hideaway facilities are exceptional. The Activities Building is one huge room approximately the size of the WV University Building in Lewisburg. It is ours for exclusive use for our stay. It has restrooms and a refrigerator, and while it has no actual kitchen, there is a large gas grill available for our use. Most of our full hookup, concrete sites are adjacent to the building.

Since our Chapter has been tasked with producing a GEAR's *Got Talent* show for the first night of the Rally, we will be spending a fair amount of time putting it together. The talent can be from anyone who

is registered for GEAR. We have several acts already lined up but if you would like to perform in the show or need more information, contact Ron Hazelett or Bruce Taylor. We are also in need of anyone with Audio/Video experience as well as Stage Hands.

The Maestros will be providing some of the acts as well as providing accompaniment or backup for others. All participants are encouraged to join us for Music Camp for all or even part of the time.

Wednesday, November 5th will be our first and only run through of the entire show on the Ocean Lakes stage, so participants will need to keep Wednesday free.

In addition to producing the Wednesday night *Got Talent* show, we still need to have programs rehearsed for the morning Coffee Times at GEAR. That is why the Music Camp dates will be extended at Hideaway and our relocation to Ocean Lakes will happen on Tuesday, November 4th.

Myrtle Beach will be the site for the 2025 edition of the GREAT EASTERN AREA RALLY. If you are sitting on this fence post, or if you have simply forgotten to make your reservation, now is the time to act. Sites are still available. To make a reservation for your site at Ocean Lakes Family Campground in Myrtle Beach you will need to call them directly at 877 510-1413. Use the code "2025 FMCA Eastern Area" when making site reservations. You cannot make your site reservation on-line—it MUST be by phone. After you make your site reservation you must also register for GEAR by calling FRVA, or by using the mail-in registration form found in the latest issue of family RVing. You can also register directly on-line.

When you register for GEAR you will also have the opportunity to purchase tickets for the Christmas Show at the Alabama Theater for a Matinee performance on Friday, November 7th at 1:30 PM. This is an excellent show and the ticket prices are lower than the local rate per David Fowler (who lives in Myrtle Beach). At last count only 100 tickets were still available.

Ocean Lakes is a mecca for beach enthusiasts—and who isn't? Myrtle Beach has literally every beach activity you can imagine. Couple that with great restaurants (especially seafood) and great entertainment shows and you have one of the premier vacation destinations east of the Mississippi.

For the Maestros, the Recreation Hall is ideal. It will be a great venue for the Talent Show as well as our morning performances for Coffee and Donuts.

A Word About Perry, GA and Music Camp 2026

As many of you may know, the winter 2026 International Convention for FRVA will again be in Perry, Georgia in March, as it was this past March. Likewise, it will be in Perry again in 2027. This is because of a three year trial proposal by many of the vendors in order to improve their participation and commitment of resources. Since Georgia is in the Southeast Area that means the Southeast would normally be the host for the rallies. However, to give the Southeast Area a break, the Eastern Area will be the host for the 2026 event. That means following GEAR this year there will only be about 3½ months to prepare for an International Convention. Therefore, the Eastern Area has decided not to hold GEAR in 2026, like the Southeast Area has done in years past with their Area Rally.

For the Eastern Sharps & Flats this leaves us with many decisions and opportunities. We may decide to suspend Music Camp in 2026 or continue on with Music Camp in spite of there not being a Great Eastern Area Rally. If we decide to hold Music Camp the opportunities are endless. When should we schedule it? Where should we schedule it? Is this the year to try something new—maybe a cruise—maybe something in a location outside of the Eastern Area boundaries?

Think about it. We'll have lots to talk about in South Carolina this year.
