We have arranged for the July, 2026, Rally to be held at Cozy Acres Campground in Powhatan, VA. We have worked with the campground staff to save 14 campsites for our group. There is a variety of sites in various prices ranges.

The campground has agreed to hold the campsites until June, 2026, however, we recommend that you make your reservations as soon as possible in order to get the site that you desire.

They will require one night's deposit to hold your site.

Your co-hosts will be on waterfront sites. The Petersons will be on Site 117 and the Pittmans will be on Site 118. These sites allow our RVs to face each other and the gathering spot for the rally will be between these two sites.

All sites have full hookups. The prices range from \$62.00/night to \$90.00/night. The sites that we have secured, along with the prices and a brief description, are listed below. If the sites we blocked are no longer available, the campground may have other sites, however, we encourage you to book sooner instead of later. Remember to mention "Cardinal Virginians" when booking your site.

Special note from Timm Seaman:


The 2026 Cajun RV Rally is scheduled for April 9-13 and April 16-20 2026 in New Iberia, LA.

Back in the 80's, Cardinal Virginians member Timm Seaman was a vital part of NASCAR.

For each race, he worked in the scoring stand, manually scoring laps for the Skoal Bandit 33 race car driven by Harry Gant. For a track like Martinsville, this meant manually writing down the time from a timing clock every few seconds when Harry's car crossed the start/finish line, for 500 laps!

When our Cardinal Virginians toured the Martinsville Speedway at our April 2019 rally, Timm explained to us how the manual scoring worked, and how he used his knowledge of scoring to develop the first computerized scoring system named "Scorekeeper".

Timm was recently contacted by the NASCAR Hall of Fame in Charlotte, NC, and they plan to have a special display of the scoring system and process next year!

Timm will keep us informed. (Sounds like a rally opportunity).
