FRVA Data Management System Update (FRVA Website); It's very important to be aware of the pending change of FRVA Data Management Systems (FRVA Website) mentioned below. Each family member (spouses) must have their own email address for access to the FRVA website. After the update, everyone will login using their own email address. I don't think it will be difficult, but you must be aware. The message received by Chapter Officers follows. The new membership database switch will happen on December 8, 2025. It's very important to note that the login for the website will be different. If you have that webpage bookmarked, it will not work. Please delete your bookmark and once you have signed into the new system, you can resave your bookmark. You must have an email address on file to log in to the website. Be sure to check/update your profile now, before the switch. Both names on the membership records should have their own email address. You will not be able to log into the website without an email address.

## Rally Updates:

**NOW AVAILABLE FOR REGISTRATION!** Into the Smokies FRVA 2026 International Area **Destination Rally**; Mail-in registration is now open for the 2026 International Area Destination Rally, May 13-17, 2026, in Sevierville, TN. Camping will be at The Ridge Outdoor Resort, 1250 Middle Creek Road in Sevierville. Jacky and I have stayed at this resort and it is very nice with an outstanding facility. We also have the opportunity of staying up to four additional nights at the rally rate of \$79.99 per night. A copy of the registration form is attached to this email so register now!

Myrtle Beach, SC Foothills Travelers Rally, April 7<sup>th</sup> through the 10<sup>th</sup>, 2026: This rally was first mentioned in the August 2025 Newsletter and as of today we have eight (8) memberships booked with the campground. Everyone enjoys Myrtle Beach, there are tons of things to do there, and lots of restaurant choices so I hope we have other members join us. Following is the original post.

Jacky and I will be hosting a chapter rally in Myrtle Beach on April 7th through the 10th at Hideaway RV Resort, 101 Cypress RV Way, Myrtle Beach. SC 29588. This will be our first weekday rally and, since most of our members are retired, this should be no problem. I really don't have to describe Myrtle Beach to anyone because I think all of us have been there at some point. Hideaway is located right on the Intracoastal Waterway within sight of the Socastee swing bridge and has docks and a boat ramp right on the waterway. Hideaway is within minutes of just about any kind of dining you can imagine and of course, seafood galore! We will have the use of a large activity center if needed but we are not planning any large group meals at the campground so the ladies can have a much-deserved break! We have reserved a block of campsites near each other at a rate of just \$54.90 plus taxes per night. You may upgrade to a waterfront site for an extra charge or arrive earlier or stay later if desired. You must contact Hideaway at 843-444-2119 by October 5th, 2025, to reserve one of these campsites. You may book after October 5<sup>th</sup> at the same rate but they cannot guarantee one of the adjacent campsites or availability. Therefore, please reserve your campsite as soon as possible. NOTE!! This Myrtle Beach rally replaces the April 2026 Clemson rally we discussed but couldn't book because we couldn't get a host for it. CAMPSITES STILL AVAILABLE!

Mount Airy, NC, Foothills Travelers Rally, June 16<sup>th</sup> through the 19<sup>th</sup>, 2026: This rally was first mentioned in the September 2025 Newsletter and as of today, we have four (4) memberships who have booked with the campground. This is a beautiful campground and will be a relief from the summer heat. Please contact the campground and book your registration. Be sure to mention you are with the Foothills Travelers for the rally rate. Our campsites are at the very top of this campground and it's a hike if you don't book one of the sites that have been reserved for the Foothills Travelers. Following is the original post.

Mike and Kathy Keith will be hosting a chapter rally at Mayberry Campground in Mt. Airy, NC on Tuesday June 16th through June 19th, 2026. We will have use of a covered shelter with tables. A block of campsites near the shelter and each other have been reserved at a rate of \$55 plus tax per night. You are welcome to come early and stay later based on availability. You must contact Mayberry Campground at 336-789-6199 by Dec 1, 2025, to reserve one of these campsites. You may book after Dec 1st but there is no guarantee your site will be adjacent to the rally group or available. Therefore, please reserve your campsite as soon as possible.
