## June 2026 Rally

***Greetings! Barbara and I are new to the Cardinal Virginians, but we have volunteered to host the June 2026 rally, along with Tim & Donna Handy.***

We have confirmed dates for the June 2026 rally at Wytheville KOA (Wytheville VA): Thursday, June 25 through Sunday, June 28.

They have blocked off the entire lower ("L") section for us. That's way more than we'll need, but better too many than too few sites. (I didn't ask for that many – they volunteered it). These are all premium big-rig sites, some pull-throughs and some back-ins, but nothing that's difficult to get in or out of. I booked Site L17 for Barbara and me, and added a day on the front end for us to setup. Tim & Donna will also come a day early, and they will be staying in L18. (see site map, attached)

Reservations are available now, and the block will be held until April 30. Rates are about \$80-82 per night (standard). They said they don't usually discount for less than 25 RVs, but I'm negotiating with the owner about that. And of course, there's always a 10% discount for KOA Rewards members – I don't know how many of our group are also KOA members.

Meetings and group meals: They said we could use the pavilion at the upper part of the campground, but I think that's too far for many of our folks to walk (and it's a slight

uphill). Either folks would have to rent a golf car or we'd have to ferry people back and forth, which would be a pain. I asked if we could just do the popup shelter thing like we did at Stuarts Draft, and they were okay with that. We would set up between the back-in sites (L17 – L22) and the pond. They could even move some extra tables and a fire ring there to accommodate us. We'll just have to pray for good weather!

Let me know your thoughts/questions/suggestions about this. Are we on the right track? If not, please let me know ASAP.

We have arranged for the July, 2026, Rally to be held at Cozy Acres Campground in Powhatan, VA. We have worked with the campground staff to save 14 campsites for our group. There is a variety of sites in various prices ranges.

The campground has agreed to hold the campsites until June, 2026, however, we recommend that you make your reservations as soon as possible in order to get the site that you desire.

They will require one night's deposit to hold your site.

Your co-hosts will be on waterfront sites. The Petersons will be on Site 117 and the Pittmans will be on Site 118. These sites allow our RVs to face each other and the gathering spot for the rally will be between these two sites.

All sites have full hookups. The prices range from \$62.00/night to \$90.00/night. The sites that we have secured, along with the prices and a brief description, are listed below. If the sites we blocked are no longer available, the campground may have other sites, however, we encourage you to book sooner instead of later. Remember to mention "Cardinal Virginians" when booking your site.
