ARTICLE IV - BOARD OF DIRECTORS

1. The Board of Directors of this Association is composed of two representatives from each Chapter and members of the Executive Board.

2. The Chapter President as well as the National Director of each Chapter in the Eastern Area shall be a member of EAMA's Board of Directors. A Chapter may select/elect a designated representative to serve on EAMA's Board of Directors in lieu of the Chapter President and or National Director. in which case, the Chapter must notify EAMA's Secretary, signed by the Chapter's President, of such designated representation no less than seven (7) days prior to the meeting.

3. All members of the Board of Directors shall serve without compensation. Reasonable expenses for related business of EAMA may be reimbursed as directed by the Association President, with the concurrence of the Executive Board following guidelines established by the Board of Directors. Reimbursement shall not exceed the prevailing rate as stated in the current FMCA Policy & Procedures.
